Hand Bearing Compass Item #2005

Two methods of use:

- 1. To take a bearing of an object hold the compass at eye level and read down the line of sight. The number under the object is the bearing. The infinity prism provides in-focus compass readings from eye to arms length.
- For quick orientation look down at the magnifying lens at the 3 o'clock position and read the RED number.
