Since the 1700's, when Admiral Fitzroy took Charles Darwin on the HMS Beagle to the Galapagos Islands, the stormglass has been used for predicting weather one to two days in advance. It works indoors or out. Variations in the crystal formations from day to day signify what weather changes to expect.

The Weems Stormglass is packaged in a handsome velvet-lined black gift box with brass mounting accessories (to enable either wall or counter/table top fixed mounting).

The Stormglass can also be mounted on an attractive and informative display plaque crafted from pure American hardwood in a mahogany finish. An engraved plate, which acts as a key, illustrates each phase of weather predicted by the Stormglass. Also on the engraved plate is a brief description of the unique origins of this mysterious weather predictor. This display makes a nice addition to this already distinctive gift.
